For GPNs wishing to develop their skills, a new course has been developed in partnership with Birmingham City University and the University of Wolverhampton. **Fundamentals+** will further your understanding of the organisational and strategic issues facing general practice and develop your knowledge and skills in a range of key areas.

The course may form preparation for further academic programmes, such as Advanced Clinical Practice and Specialist Practice.

This opportunity is open to all GPNs in the Black Country & West Birmingham who have at least 12 months experience. Applicants may have completed the Fundamentals of General Practice Nursing course previously, but this is not essential

By the end of the programme, you will feel empowered and equipped to take a proactive leadership role in your practice and wider primary care network.

The course is fully funded for eligible applicants, however places are limited.
